Guest Buddy Responsibilities

- Protect the Miracle League athlete at all times. Where the athlete goes, the Buddy goes.
- Help your athlete by holding their hand, pushing their wheelchair, or leading them in their power chair.
- Assist the Miracle League athlete according to their needs while giving them as much freedom as possible to play their own game. Always help the player get the ball, and show them where to throw it.
- Ensure the athlete has FUN!
- Be of good spirit, enthusiasm, and attitude in motivating the athlete. Give encouragement, clap, and cheer.



Game Day Guidelines

- Arrive 15 minutes before your assigned time.
- Your group leader(s) must be present for the duration of the assignment.
- No cell phones so you can give your athlete your full attention.
- No cleats or flip-flops on the field for your safety as well as our athletes.
- If your organization has a team jersey or shirt, wear it so your group can be recognized for volunteering!
